

ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY

Carwood Motor Units Limited is a private company, established in 1966. The principal activity of the company is the provision of automotive technical services and remanufacturing facilities covering diesel and petrol fuel injection, electronics, auto-electrical, air conditioning and heating systems, complemented by the distribution of specialised components for commercial vehicles, buses, coaches, military vehicles, heavy plant and light vehicles.

The management and staff of Carwood Motor Units Limited understand that these processes have an impact on the environment so the company is committed to improving its overall environmental performance through the following measures:

1. To seek to reduce the environmental impact and prevent pollution in the operation of our manufacturing and remanufacturing processes
2. To set objectives and targets to reduce the waste material and products caused by our processes
